
# Divine Liturgy Propers, November 16, 2014 TWENTY-THIRD SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST




## Troparion of the holy apostle and evangelist Matthew- Tone 3











## Kontakion of the apostle and evangelist Matthew- Tone 4




