Vesper Propers, December 7, 2014 Twenty-sixth Sunday after Pentecost Prefestive Day of the Maternity of the Holy Anna



A true pastor and teacher of the faithful, he exercised great charity toward all, defended strenuously the freedom of the Church and the doctrine of orthodox faith against the Arians. 
