**Stichera of the Transfiguration -** *Tone 4* 






**Cantor:** My soul is waiting for the Lord, I count on his word.

All repeat "O Lord, when you were transfigured..."


Cantor: Let the watchman count on daybreak and Israel on the Lord.

Cantor: (Tone 2) Now and ever...


