Troparion of the Baptist- Tone 4


The head of the Fore - runner arose from the earth like a star, send-ing out

dis-cov - ered your head, a rose of great holiness from which heal-ing al - ways




comes to us. As you did of old, now also preach re-pent - ance to the world.
