



## Propers for the Liturgy of the Presanctified Gifts Monday in the Third Week of the Great Fast

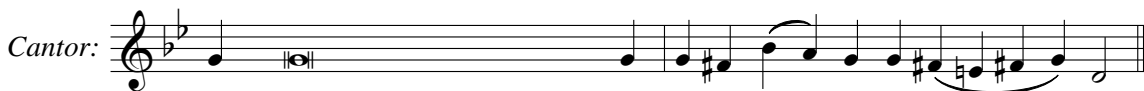

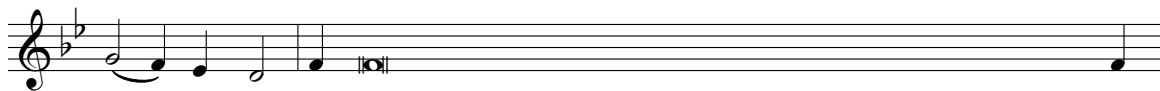
