

Divine Liturgy Propers MID-PENTECOST WEDNESDAY

Immediately after the opening blessing, the following is sung once by the priest and then twice by the faithful:




Troparion of Mid-Pentecost - *Tone 8:*






Kontakion of Mid-Pentecost - *Tone 4*

Verse: Praise the Lord, for a psalm is good. May praise delight our God.


Alleluia - *Tone 1* (Psalm 73:2,12):



Verse: Remember your flock which you acquired long ago.


Verse: God is our King from all ages. He has accomplished salvation in the middle of the earth.



Paschal "Our Father" - melody of the Canon of Pascha








The Paschal troparion "Christ is risen from the dead. * By death . . ." is sung once in place of "We have seen the true light; . . ."
