Thus sanc - ti - fy - ing bod - y and soul,




O - ver cre - a - tion made me a rul - er!

Flee - ing from pas - sions, vir - tues e'er seek - ing,




But Sa - tan tempt - ed, lured me to death.



**Kontakion of Cheesefare Sunday - Tone 6**



cry-ing out to you: O mer-ciful Lord, have mercy on me, for I have fall-en.


**Prokeimenon of Cheesefare Sunday - Tone 8 (Psalm 75:12,2):**
