(on 5) My soul is longing for the Lord more than watchman for daybreak.




Cantor: Let the watchman count on daybreak (on 4) and Israel on the Lord.

Aposticha doxastikon of the Prodigal Son - $Tone\ 6\ samohlasen$




Cantor: (*Tone 1*) Because with the Lord there is mercy and fullness of redemption, (on 3) Israel indeed he will redeem from all its iniquity.


Stichera of the Postfeast - *Tone 1 samohlasen*



Cantor: Praise the Lord all the nations; Psalm 116 (on 2) acclaim him all you people.








Cantor: (*Tone 2*) Glory...
