




Troparion of the Resurrection - *Tone 2*




When you de - scended to death, O Im - mor - tal Life, you de - stroyed

Troparion of John the Baptist - *Tone 4:*




Proph - et and fore - run - ner of the com - ing of Christ, al - though we honor you with



and the world, O my Savior, sings your prais - es for - ev - er.


Prokeimenon - Tone 1 (Psalm 117:14,18):
