Verse: Planted in the house of the Lord, he will flourish in the courts of our God.








## Paschal "Our Father" - melody of the Canon of Pascha










The Paschal troparion "Christ is risen from the dead. \* By death . . ." is sung once in place of "We have seen the true light; . . ."
