**The Synaxis of the holy Forerunner, Prophet, and Baptist John.** A “synaxis” feast follows one of the great feasts, and highlights a major personage of the previous day's celebration. We remember today the work of the Forerunner, John, who baptized Christ.

### Kontakion of the Synaxis - Tone 6






